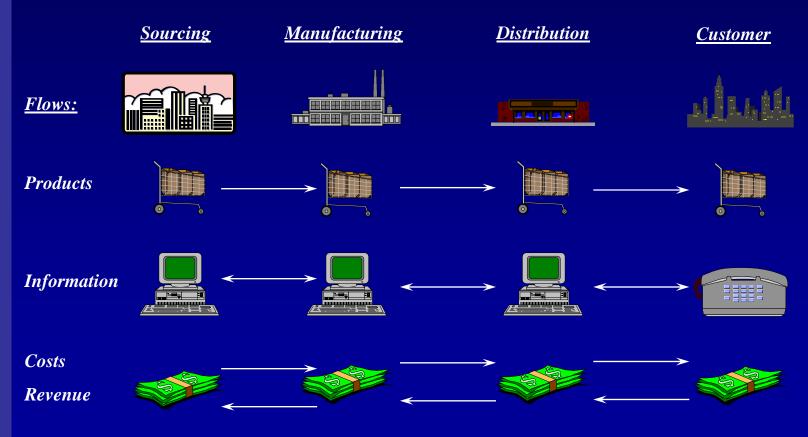

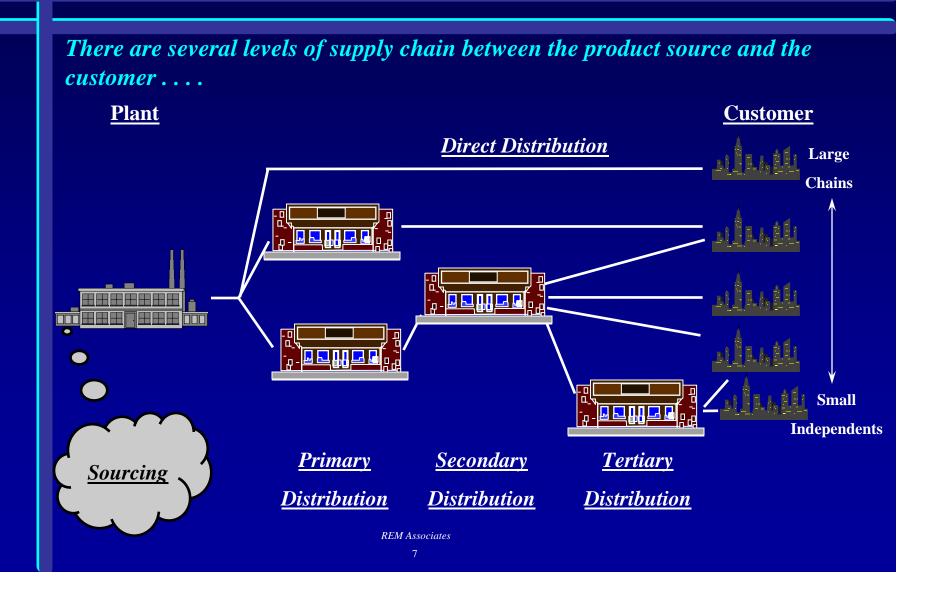

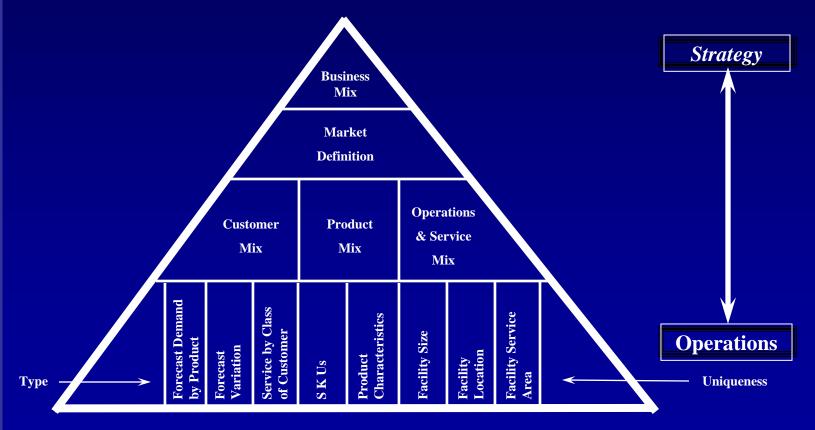
The logic of supply chain management relates directly to the flow of products, information, and costs through the business to the customer....

- Inventory carrying costs

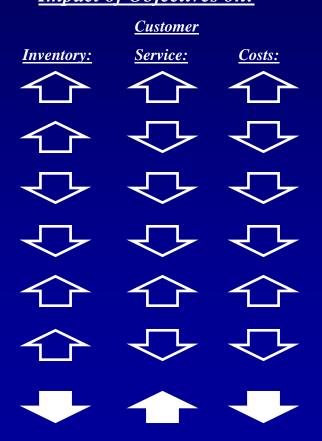
